## **NORMS FOR RE-ADMISSION TO B.TECH, B.ARCH, M.PLANNING, M.ARCH, M.TECH AND MCA PROGRAMMES UNDER APJ ABDUL KALAM TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY ( KTU )**

### **FROM OTHER UNIVERSITIES IN KERALA.**

**As the Engineering Colleges in Kerala are now affiliated to KTU, the students who have discontinued their studies in the affiliated colleges and enrolled in other Universities in Kerala are given provision to continue their studies in KTU as per the following norms:**

- i) The students should have been eligible for re-admission as per the regulations of the parent University if the programme had been continued in the parent University.**
- ii) The students who seek re-admission should have passed all subjects in the lower semesters.**
- iii) Admission of the student to KTU will be based on the recommendation of the Principal of the college in which the applicant had studied and the admission will only be to that college, in that branch of study.**
- iv) A Committee constituted by KTU shall examine such re-admission cases and shall decide on any addition or substitution of courses the student has to undergo based on the courses so far completed and in line with the current KTU curriculum.**
- v) The credits so far earned by the student in the parent University will be transferred to KTU as per the clauses in the ordinance/regulations for the respective programme and as per the pattern of credits assigned by KTU.**
- vi) The rules and regulations applicable to the batch of students to which the applicant is admitted shall be applicable to him/her.**
- vii) Students who have completed all courses up to the last but one semester shall continue in the parent University and no re-**



**admission is planned for them. The respective colleges may arrange classes for them and the parent University may award the degree as per their regulations.**

**ORDER**

Vide reference cited above, **provision for migration of students from other universities** was placed in the 5th Academic Council held on 16/08/2019, vide item no.005.4.03. The Academic Council discussed the matter in detail and suggested necessary changes in the provisions for migration .

The provision for migration of students from other universities, after incorporating suggestions made by the Academic Council is as detailed below:

Item No.	Description
1	Migration to the University from other Universities shall be permitted only if the parent university should have affiliation in any of the Professional bodies such as AIU/AICTE/UGC/Council of Architects/etc.
2.	The student shall be permitted to migrate only if he/she fulfills the University eligibility criteria for admission to the course applied for migration.
3.	The migration shall be permitted <b>only up to the fifth semester</b> of the B.Tech programme and, <b>half the duration of the programme</b> in the case of other programmes.
4.	The admission shall be offered on migration basis through lateral transfer of credits.
5.	The students shall be allowed to migrate to the University subject to satisfying the rules and regulations of the University as regards to , maximum number of backlogs, grade points, minimum credit requirement for promotion to higher semesters, etc.
6.	The student shall be offered admission in any of the affiliated colleges/institutions of the University subject to availability of seats. The student shall produce <b>no objection certificate</b> from the concerned college/institute in this regard.
7	The students offered admission shall have to take transitory courses/additional courses of the previous semesters to satisfy the



	programme requirement as recommended by the concerned Board of Studies.
8.	The students offered admission shall pay the migration fees and the University fees as prescribed by the University. <b>The application processing fee(University fee) shall be Rs.5000/-(Rupees five thousand only) and the migration fees shall be Rs.20,000/-(Rupees twenty thousand only).</b> The migration fee is charged for the meeting expenses of the concerned Board of Studies to decide on the student suitability for migration and to recommend the transitory courses/additional courses to be done by the student to fulfill the academic requirement of the University. The processing fee shall be paid along with the application, and the migration fee shall be paid to the University at the time of offering admission. The fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances. The students in any of the Engineering colleges/institutions , which, before the commencement of KTU Act remained affiliated to Universities except Deemed Universities in the State of Kerala, are exempted from paying the processing fee and the migration fee.
9.	The migrated students shall follow the rules and regulations of the University.
10.	The students offered admission shall produce a migration certificate from the parent University at the time of admission.
11.	The student offered admission shall produce a character certificate from the parent institute/University at the time of admission.
12.	Regulations, Scheme and Syllabus of the respective specialization attested by the Registrar of the parent University or equivalent authority shall be submitted to the University along with the application seeking migration to the University.
13.	Attested copies of all certificates and mark lists from 10th onwards shall be submitted along with the application for migration(Original Certificates and mark lists shall be produced as and when required by the University).
14.	Assessment of the student suitability for migration in terms of programmes, backlogs, grade points, credit requirements, etc shall be done by the concerned Board of Studies.
15.	Assessment of the transitory courses/ additional courses to be done by the student as per the academic requirement of the University shall be as recommended by the concerned Board of Studies.
