**ORDER**

Vide reference cited 1 above, the rules for B.Tech(Honours) have been published in the website of the University. A request was received from Govt. Engineering College, Barton hill for considering Interdisciplinary PG Programme in Translational Engineering to be considered for B.Tech Civil Engineering students to register for B.Tech(Honours). Requests were received from student representatives to change the regulation regarding institutional eligibility(2015) to that of 2019 scheme. It was placed in the 6th meeting of the Academic Council held on 26/10/2019 vide item 2 under reference.

The Academic Council **revised** B.Tech(Hnours) regulations for B.Tech 2015 Scheme as follows:

1. Registration of B.Tech(Honours) shall be along with regular course/ Exam registration of Sixth semester.
2. Students with no credit arrears & CGPA of 8 or above, upto 4th semester at the time of registration only are eligible to register for B.Tech(Honours). The mandatory CGPA at the end of eighth semester is 8 or higher for the award of B.Tech(Honours).
3. After registration for B.Tech(Honours), if a student fails in any course, he/she will not be eligible for B.Tech(Honours). However, the credits and grades thus far earned by them will be shown in the grade card but will not be considered for the calculation of CGPA.
- 4(a). The student has to earn minimum 12 credits taking at least 4 additional courses, of which 2 should be from the list of B.Tech electives offered by the respective stream. However, the elective courses undergone for the normal B.Tech programme could not be opted to attain credits for B.Tech(Honours) and vice versa. Remaining 2 courses must be MOOC courses approved by the University.
  - (b). MOOC courses shall be of duration not less than 12 weeks and shall be recommended by the Board of Studies/Curriculum Committee and approved by the Academic Council.
  - (c). Grace mark / Moderation will not be applicable for the additional courses undergone for B.Tech(Honours).
