**ORDER**

Vide paper read as (1) above and other similar requests received by the University it had been requested to reduce the minimum cumulative credits required to register for the B.Arch courses in higher semesters. The B.Arch Curriculum Committee held on 17-11-2017 considered the matter and recommended changes in regulation vide paper read as (3).

Considering the urgency, the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, exercising powers vide clause (5), para (14) chapter II of the APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University Act 2015, has subject to ratification by the syndicate, accorded sanction to the following amendments to the regulation read (2).

1. To amend clause 7 (k) of the B.Arch regulations as given below:

2. To amend clause 7 (c) viii of the B.Arch Regulation so that all semesters should carry only a maximum of 27 credits

3. To amend clause 7 (f) iii of the B.Arch Regulations so that the maximum credits that a student can register in a semester is enhanced to 30 credits.

4. To offer at least three chances to write the University examinations before effecting year out.

The above amendments will come into effect from 05-01-2018 onwards. Orders are issued accordingly.
