Student Induction Programme AY 2021-22

Engineering colleges were established to train graduates in their respective branch/department of study, have a holistic outlook towards life, and have a desire to work for national needs and beyond. The graduating students must have excellent knowledge and skills in the area of their study. However, they must also have broad understanding of society and relationships. Character needs to be nurtured as an essential quality by which they would understand and fulfil their responsibility as an engineer, a citizen and a human being. Besides the above, several meta-skills and underlying values are needed.

When new students enter an institution, they also come with diverse thoughts, backgrounds and preparations. They come into a new environment, and many of them have little knowledge of the University/college. An important task, therefore, is to welcome the new students to higher education and prepare them for their new role. Transition from school to University/college life is one of the most challenging events in a student's life. Student Induction is designed to help in the whole process.

There will be one week long induction program for the B.Tech students entering the institution, right at the start. Normal classes start only after the induction program. Purpose of the Student Induction Program is to help new students adjust and feel comfortable in the new environment, inculcate in them the ethos and culture of the institution, set a healthy daily routine, help them build bonds with other students and faculty members, develop awareness, sensitivity and understanding of the self, people around them, society at large, and nature and expose them to a sense of larger purpose and self-exploration. These would range from issues of national and international significance, ethics, sports and physical exercises, community service, sketching, artwork, and many more.

The programme is designed with the following objectives:

Enable Interaction: Designing, ice-breaking sessions, organizing formal and informal sessions with faculty/staff/senior students and alumni.

Engagement: Workshops on paper engineering, design thinking and gamification.

Enhancing Awareness: India Quiz, Interactive sessions on Institute values, human values and ethics, campus philosophy.

Emotional Connect: Video presentation, expressing their stories, etc.

Mentoring and Universal Human Values: It gets the student to explore oneself and experience the joy of learning, prepares one to stand up to peer pressure and take decisions with courage, be aware of relationships and be sensitive to others, and experience the feeling of prosperity. Need for character building has been underlined by many thinkers and universal human values provide the base.
