ORDER

Vide paper read (1), Sri. Nandhu. R, Reg No. TVE16CE-P016 has requested permission of the University to re- appear for the Oral part of Comprehensive Examination of S6 B.Tech (Part Time).

Vide Circular read (2) issued to colleges on the additional guidelines for Comprehensive Examinations, a student who appeared for both oral and written examinations and failed in total, can appear for written exam alone to get pass grade.

Vide para 5 of this Circular the oral examination marks will not be regulated in accordance with the performance in the written examination for all the comprehensive examinations in future and there will not be a separate minimum for pass. Also 2015 Admission batch of students in 'F' grade were allowed to re-appear for Oral and written part of Comprehensive Examination in the next chance.

According to clause (3) of above guidelines read (2) above a student who appeared for both Oral and Written parts of Comprehensive examination is denied the opportunity for reappearing for the Oral part of Comprehensive Examination and he has to secure the aggregate minimum (45%) by scoring high marks in the written part.

Considering the demand from the students, it was directed by the Vice Chancellor to place the grievances of students for the consideration of the Academic Council.

Vide paper read (3) Academic Council resolved to;

"extend the provision to re-appear for Oral Examination of S6 B.Tech / B.Tech (PT) Comprehensive Examination to all failed students of B.Tech 2015 and 2016



**Regulations and the same is extended to 2017 and 2018 batch students also.
However a student will get only one chance to reappear for Oral part."**

Hence sanction has been accorded by the Vice Chancellor to permit all the failed students of B.Tech (Regular) 2015 Regulations and B.Tech (Part Time) 2016 Regulations to reappear for Oral Part of S6 B.Tech / B.Tech (Part Time) Comprehensive Examination. The students of B.Tech (Regular / PT) 2016, 2017 and 2018 admissions shall be eligible for reappearance and a student will get only one chance to reappear for the Oral part of B.Tech Comprehensive Examination.
