## Circular

**Sub:** Conduct of Supplementary Examinations of various programmes for UG/PG courses scheduled from 09.09.2020: reg:-

**Ref:** 1. Recommendation of the Academic Council of the University held on 11.07.2020  
2. Resolution of the Syndicate of the University held on 22.07.2020.  
3. Detailed timetable for Supplementary Examinations published by the University on 13.08.2020 (UG,PG) & 23.08.2020 (MBA)

As per papers read 1 & 2 above, University has decided to conduct the supplementary examinations of all semesters in the conventional offline format. Accordingly, as per paper 3<sup>rd</sup> above, timetable was published by the University on 13.08.2020 (UG/PG) and 23.08.2020 (MBA) for the conduct of supplementary semester examinations. Considering the requests from B.Tech students, **odd semester supplementary examinations** will also be conducted **as a special onetime chance** this year. This is to inform all students that hereafter, the supplementary examinations of odd semester will be conducted only along with odd semester regular examinations, and that of even semester with the regular examinations of even semesters, as per regulations. So **students having supplementary examinations are requested to prepare well and make use of this opportunity to clear their pending back papers by making use of this chance.** Final year odd semester supplementary exams of PG will also be conducted (S3 exam for M.Tech, M.Plan, M.Arch, MCA second year direct and S5 exam for MCA 3 year etc.)

University is well aware of the issues related with Covid19 infections, propagations and associated issues. However, a time has come wherein **we are left with no options other than to 'live with Covid'**. It is to be noted that there are hundreds of students with few back papers, many of them are even placed, who are eagerly waiting for the conduct of these supplementary examinations and publication of results. Any further delay in the conduct of these examinations will affect their career prospects and higher education opportunities. Please note that, braving Covid 19, all national level examinations are going to be conducted as planned in the coming months. Further, **all Government offices and other functions of the State have already started functioning with increased attendance proclaiming our desire and efforts to live with the pandemic.** However, strict adherence to individual centric safety measures proposed by our health officials and regulatory agencies are to be scrupulously followed.

We would like to bring the following to the attention of students:

- University has given sufficiently early notice for the conduct of supplementary examinations.
- Centre changes will be effected and students can write examination in centers of their choice close to their home.
- Examinations will be conducted as per the published schedule, following all safety protocols specified by



regulatory agencies as part of Covid19.

Those **students who have any specific difficulty/reluctance in attending these supplementary examinations are free to avail the NEXT immediate chance.** Strict health protocols will be followed in the conduct of examinations. All Heads of Institutions are requested to contact the district administration/health department for any assistance in this regard. Detailed guidelines to the Heads of Institutions to this effect will be circulated soon.

We are sorry to inform all concerned that **requests for postponement of these supplementary examinations or change in the manner/mode of examinations WILL NOT be entertained by the University.** We request the fullest cooperation from the Heads of Institutions / faculty / staff, students and all concerned for the successful conduct of these supplementary examinations as scheduled from **09.09.2020.**
