

ANNOUNCEMENT

Sub:- Clarification on Contact Courses (Clause 6(k) of the B.Tech Ordinance) -chance given to the semester 8 completed students.

As per the clause 6(k) of the ordinance 'if a student has to earn credits only just for one course to qualify for the degree after completing eight semesters of study, the college concerned may offer a contact course on a written request by the student. The contact course is considered as a fresh registration and is to be offered by the teacher concerned who shall conduct the internal evaluation procedures and allot the marks as per the regulations. Minimum contact hours for the course shall be 20. The final examination will be conducted by the college and shall be monitored by the external academic auditor. Question paper for the examination will be given by the controller of examination. No grade above C shall be given for a contact course.

'The phrase 'earn credits only just for one course to qualify for the degree' leads to a possible doubt that the contact course is a chance given to the failed (F) courses.

There for it is clarified that the provision is applicable only for students who has one course left to earn credits due to non-accomplishment of eligibility criteria (Course Incomplete) to qualify the degree. In such cases the teacher who conducted the internal evaluation procedures of the course shall conduct the contact course on the written request by the student
