

Greetings from A P J Abdul Kalam Technological University!

1) Conducting end semester examinations as done normally. i.e. University will conduct end semester examinations.

This will take more than 2 months to complete all the lower semester examinations after the S7 examinations. There is a large possibility that the academic schedule will get lagged by around 3 months - allowing us to start the next semester only perhaps in November.

2) Conducting end semester examinations in online mode, internally, by the parent College. i.e. End semester examinations will not be conducted by the University. Instead, individual Institutions will conduct the end semester examinations. Students will be able to attend the exams at their place of stay. There will be normalisation of end sem marks considering the performance of the students in previous semester(s).

Students will not have to travel from their place of stay. Delay in academic schedule due to exams and valuation will be minimum. The students and faculty shall work together to ensure a fair evaluation.

3) Same as above except that the examinations will be conducted internally by the colleges in October, after the students are able to come to college.

In this suggestion, the odd semester classes can be commenced online immediately. An end-semester on-line examination can be avoided. Lag of semester could be minimised here as well.

4) Conducting 2020 May/June exam and Nov/Dec exam during the period Nov-Jan.

In this scenario, the next semester classes can be immediately commenced online, after the current semester classes. However students will have to attend examinations of 2 semesters during November-January.

5) Objective type examinations for all courses of regular and supplementary exam May/June will be conducted on consecutive days during October. Classes of odd semesters will commence online immediately after the present semester classes. (University require about 2 months to collect objective type questions for all courses.)

Valuation time will be minimum, less lag in schedule. If the situation does not improve in October, we may have to revert to point 2 given above.

Please post any other suggestions if found practical; we shall see if those are feasible too.
